North Park Street was re-configured in 2018 based on public input to reduce speeding and to implement cycling lanes identified in the City's Transportation Master Plan. Revisions to the pavement markings are being proposed based on public feedback and staff observations. The public is invited to attend a Public Information Centre (PIC) to share before and after results of the Road Diet and to provide input on the proposed revisions ahead of final paving.
