Applications of a non-selective herbicide known as Round Up Weather Max with Transorb 2 Technology Liquid Herbicide. Registration Number 27487 under the Pest Control Products Act (Canada) active ingredient Glyphosate (present as potassium salt) will be applied commencing on June 24, 2019 weather permitting and ending August 31, 2019.
