NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING CONCERNING PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CITY OF BROCKVILLE ZONING BY-LAW 050-2014 File No. D14-038₍₀₅₀₋₂₀₁₄₎ – 9 and 11 Pearl Street East

A complete application to amend the City of Brockville Zoning By-law 050-2014 has been submitted to the City with respect to the file detailed below.

The Planning and Operations Committee of the City of Brockville will be holding a Public Meeting to give the public an opportunity to make representations concerning the proposed amendment.

Subject property:

9 and 11 Pearl Street East

Description of lands:

Lots 182 and 183, Block 15, Plan No. 67

Proposed zoning change:

Change from R4 General Residential Zone to R4 General Residential Special Exception Zone

Proposal for the lands:

The owner is requesting a change to a special exception zone to allow for an apartment building and to request reductions to minimum front yard and minimum interior side yard requirements.

Special Exceptions proposed:

The proposed special exceptions are a reduction in minimum front yard from the required 6.0 metres to 2.0 metres and minimum interior side yard from the required 5.0 metres to 1.5 metres and 2.1 metres.

The subject lands are the subject of Zoning By-law Amendment D14-038.

Any person may attend this public meeting and make written or oral representations in support of, or opposition to, the proposed amendment. Written submissions from persons not attending the meeting should be received by the Director of Planning, City Hall, One King Street West, P.O. Box 5000, Brockville, Ontario K6V 7A5, by 17 September 2019.

Please note: Personal information is collected pursuant to Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection Privacy Act. Comments and opinion submitted on these matters become part of the public record and may be viewed by the general public; and may be published in a Planning Report and Council Agenda. Written requests for notification of the adoption of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, or of the refusal of the request, must be made to the Director of Planning for the City of Brockville at the address provided above.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the City of Brockville before a decision is granted respecting the proposed amendment, the person or public body:

- is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Brockville to the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal; and
- may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Local Planning Appeal Tribunal unless, in the opinion of the board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
